In line with the Snowsport England initiative Hemel Ski Race Club is committed to “making sure children and vulnerable adults enjoy Snow Sports in a safe environment in which they are protected from any form of poor practice or abuse.” To this end Snowsport England require all member clubs to appoint a Child Welfare Officer.

The Hemel Ski Race Club appointed Child Welfare officer is **Rod Ferguson**.

In addition to this all Club training staff are Criminal records Bureau (CRB) checked.

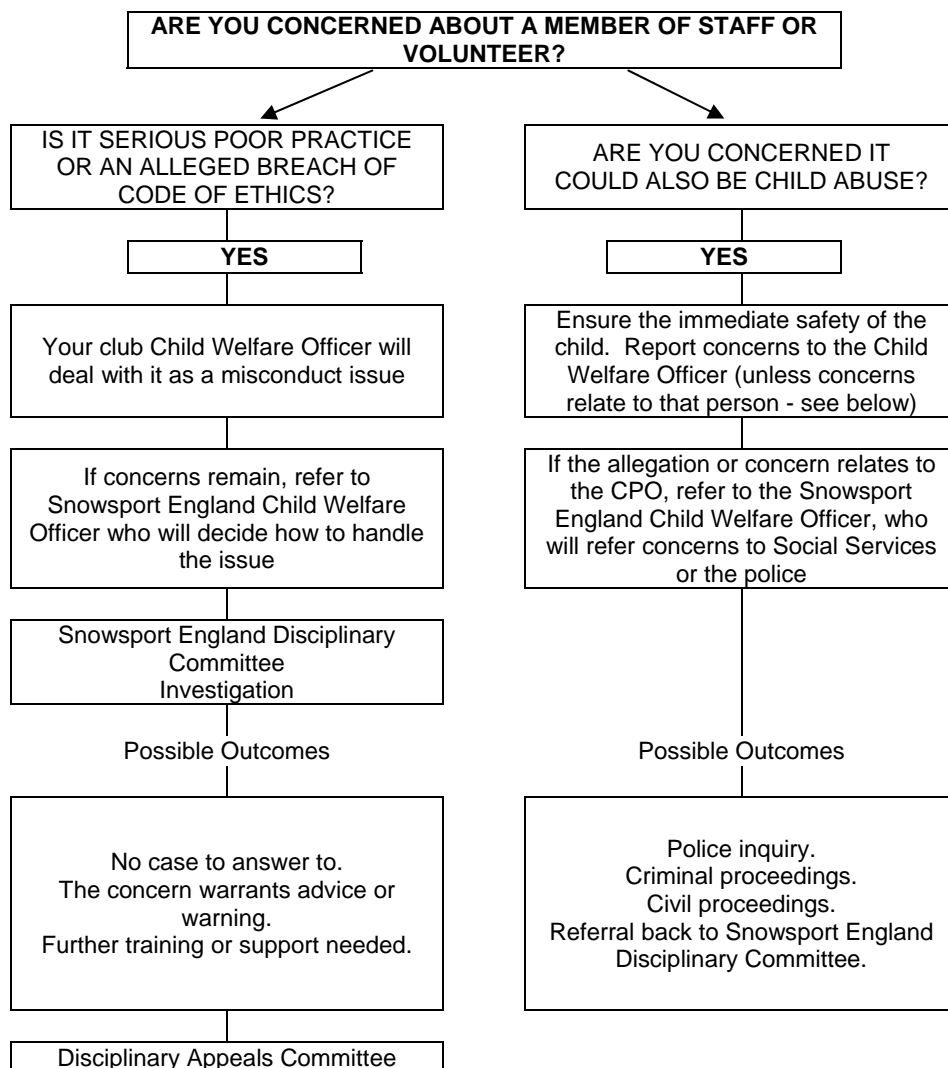
